	RECEIVER'S REQUEST FOR INSTRUCT	IONS REGARDING I	MPLEMENTATION		

1 On August 4, 2021, the Receiver submitted a Report to the Court containing a 2 recommendation that the Court order mandatory vaccination for workers who visit institutions and 3 for incarcerated persons with outside contacts. The Receiver made this recommendation in 4 response to the unprecedented challenge COVID-19 has posed to his mission to cure constitutional 5 insufficiencies in the delivery of healthcare in California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) institutions. On September 27, 2021, the Court found that CDCR was 6 7 deliberately indifferent to a substantial risk of serious harm to incarcerated persons by failing to 8 act reasonably to control COVID-19 and ordered that the Receiver's recommendation be 9 implemented. ECF No. 3684.

10 Twenty-three days after this Court issued its order, implementation has not yet begun. After two weeks of cooperation between CCHCS and CDCR developing the framework for 11 12 implementing the Court's order, on October 11, 2021, counsel for Defendants informed the 13 Reciever's counsel that Defendants wanted to delay the implementation plan by three weeks. 14 Forster Decl. ¶ 4, Ex. C. The Receiver declined to agree to the delay, and Defendants and the 15 Receiver submitted a joint implementation plan committing to full compliance with this Court's 16 order by November 29, 2021, though Defendants also noted their preference for a later 17 implementation date. Forster Decl. ¶ 6, Ex. C; ECF No. 3694 at 5. Four days later, Defendants 18 suggested to this Court that they were not bound to follow the agreed-upon and submitted 19 timeframe. ECF No. 3703 at 2-3 ("[A]s noted in the implementation plan . . . Defendants and the 20 Receiver disagreed about the appropriate timeframe for implementation. It does not appear that 21 any specific timeframe governs compliance with this Court's September 27 order . . . . ").

After the Court ordered Defendants and the Receiver to meet and confer over this apparent misunderstanding, Defendants indicated during an October 18, 2021 meet and confer that they would not commit to *any* date for implementation. Forster Decl. ¶ 9. Defendants stated that they needed additional time to consult with CDCR's labor relations staff, have them confer with CCHCS labor relations staff, and determine a way to implement this Court's order in compliance with the Dills Act. *Id.* Defendants also asserted, for the first time, that they were unwilling to

28

implement this Court's order prior to meeting and conferring with bargaining units under the Dills
 Act. *Id.* They offered two reasons for this position.

First they contended that, despite having filed an implementation plan with this Court
committing to compliance by a certain date, there was no specific date by which Defendants were
obligated to comply with the Court order. Forster Decl. ¶ 10. See also ECF No. 3703 at 3 ("no
specific timeframe governs compliance with this Court's September 27 order . . . ."). They further
suggested that, in the absence of a Court-ordered deadline, they may have to meet and confer with
bargaining units prior to implementation. *Id*.

9 Second, Defendants suggested that COVID-19 may not currently constitute an emergency
10 permitting implementation prior to bargaining.<sup>1</sup> *Id*.

11 In that October 18 meet and confer over the timeline for implementation, Defendants also asserted that they need more time in order to have their motion for a stay decided prior to 12 13 implementation. Forster Decl. ¶ 11. But that motion still has not been filed, more than three 14 weeks after this Court's order. Asked about the timing of that filing, Defendants declined to say any more than that it "may" come this week. Id. In any event, whether implementation of the 15 16 Court's order should be delayed is the precise question that would be posed by Defendants' 17 anticipated motion for a stay. Delaying implementation until Defendants eventually ask this Court 18 for a stay would in effect grant Defendants the relief they state they intend to seek without this 19 Court deciding that a stay is warranted.

20At the Receiver's urging, a further meet and confer was scheduled to include the pertinent21labor relations staff. Forster Decl. ¶¶ 12, 13. At that conference, Defendants stated definitively22that, absent a court order or emergency, they would need to provide notice to the unions and an

<sup>1</sup> The Dills Act requires that a government employer meet and confer with all bargaining units 24 about a change within the scope of their representation prior to implementation, except in cases of emergency. Gov. Code § 3516.5. Defendants have the discretion to invoke an emergency 25 exception obviating the need to provide notice and bargain prior to implementation. "In cases of 26 emergency when the employer determines that a law, rule, resolution, or regulation must be adopted immediately without prior notice or meeting ... the administrative officials ... shall 27 provide such notice and opportunity to meet in confer in good faith at the earliest practical time following the adoption of such law, rule, resolution, or regulation." opportunity to bargain over impacts prior to implementation. *Id.* Defendants reiterated that a
 court order would allow implementation to begin immediately. *Id.* Defendants also stated that
 they have not reached a decision on whether they would be willing to invoke the Dills Act's
 emergency exception. *Id.*

5 In light of Defendants' statement that they would proceed with the implementation plan of 6 the Court's September 27, 2021 order immediately if this Court ordered implementation on a 7 particular timeline, but that they will not cooperate on implementation prior to bargaining absent 8 this Court ordering a specific timeline, the Receiver is lodging with the Court a Proposed Order 9 that the parties' previously-submitted implementation plan be adopted, with dates slightly 10 modified given the delay that has already occurred, as reflected in the accompanying proposed 11 order.

Any claim that there is no ongoing emergency is strongly contradicted by the facts. In just
the last two weeks, there were major outbreaks in California State Prison Corcoran (93 cases);
Wasco State Prison (51 cases); High Desert State Prison (23 cases); Centinela State Prison (16
cases); and North Kern State Prison (10 cases).<sup>2</sup> The Governor's Proclamation of a State of
Emergency from COVID-19 remains in effect.<sup>3</sup>

17 As this Court previously found, remedying the ongoing violation of the Eighth 18 Amendment rights of every incarcerated person in CDCR custody, and protecting incarcerated 19 persons from an ongoing public health emergency, is a matter of great urgency warranting the implementation of this Court's prior order. # **Declaration of Katherine Forster**

I declare, under penalty of perjury and pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, as follows:

- 1. I am Katherine M. Forster, counsel to the Receiver, J. Clark Kelso, in the above captioned matter. Since the Court's September 27 order, I have been involved in negotiations over implementation of the order. CCHCS was represented in these negotiations by Lara Saich and Migdalia Siaca at the staff level, and by myself in conferences to meet and confer. I submit this declaration to inform the Court of the progress of efforts to meet and confer with Defendants regarding a timeline to implement the Court's order.
- 2. On October 11, 2021, at 2:12 pm, Linda Ostling transmitted CDCR's proposed Joint Implementation plan on behalf of Defendants. A copy of the correspondence transmitting this draft and asking for the Receiver's approval or concerns is attached as Exhibit A. A copy of the attached draft, containing the November 29 implementation date, is attached as Exhibit B. This correspondence and the attached draft were provided to me by Roscoe Barrow, Chief Counsel, CCHCS.
- 3. CDCR's proposed joint implementation plan reflected the agreement to implement the Court's order prior to bargaining subject to the Dills Act's emergency exception. The draft joint implementation plan required full vaccination of all individuals covered by the order by November 29, 2021. This timeline of just under seven weeks for full implementation left no time for notice and an opportunity to meet and confer prior to beginning implementation. It therefore reflected CDCR and CCHCS's agreement that implementation would proceed prior to bargaining pursuant to the Dills Act emergency exception.
- 4. Later on October 11, 2021, Lara Saich transmitted the Receiver's edits to the plan proposed by CDCR. On October 12, 2021, at 11:51 am, Damon McClain transmitted a revised joint implementation plan, accepting the Receiver's edits. However, Mr. McClain also proposed delaying implementation by three weeks. The parties agreed to a conference to meet and confer over Defendants' proposal at noon on October 12, 2021. Correspondence between the parties regarding this proposed change and coming to final agreement on the joint filing is attached as Exhibit C.
- 5. During the noon conference on October 12, 2021, to meet and confer over the implementation deadline at noon, Mr. McClain stated that Defendants wanted to delay implementation for three weeks in order to create sufficient time for a possible motion to stay, which they had not yet decided whether or not to file, to be ruled on before implementation began. At that time, Mr. McClain indicated that if the Receiver did not agree to extend time, Defendants would like to include a footnote indicating that Defendants had requested additional time and that the Receiver did not agree to that request.
- 6. On October 12, 2021, at 12:28 pm, I corresponded with Mr. McClain indicating that the Receiver did not agree to delay implementation by three weeks and would review a

version including the footnote that Defendants had orally requested. That correspondence is also included in Exhibit C. The Receiver and Defendants subsequently jointly filed an implementation plan requiring full compliance with the order by November 29, 2021.

- 7. Following the decision of Kern County Superior Court Judge Bernard C. Barmann, Jr. to issue a temporary restraining order enjoining implementation of the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) August 19 order as to Bargaining Unit 6, on October 14, 2021, at 12:22 pm, Receiver's counsel requested to meet and confer with Defendants regarding how implementation of this Court's order should proceed. At 6:55 pm, citing statements by Receiver's counsel earlier that day in court that he intended to seek clarification that the temporary restraining order did not prohibit implementation of this Court's order, Defendants declined to meet and confer over implementation. This correspondence is attached as Exhibit D.
- 8. On October 18, 2021, at 8:45 am, following the Court's October 15 order instructing the Receiver and Defendants to meet and confer over a timeline for implementation of the Court's September 27 order, Receiver's counsel requested to meet and confer with Defendants. Defendants agreed to meet at 3:00 pm that day. This correspondence is also included in Exhibit D.
- 9. Defendants refused to commit to any date for implementation at the October 18, 2021 conference. Defendants stated that they would need additional time to consult with CDCR's labor relations staff, have them confer with CCHCS labor relations staff, and determine a way to implement this Court's order in compliance with the Dills Act. Asked with which individuals Defendants would need to confer, Defendants said they did not know. Defendants, for the first time, after weeks of negotiations over implementation, said they may need to meet and confer with bargaining units under the Dills Act prior to implementation.
- 10. Defendants gave two reasons at the October 18 conference for why they may need to meet and confer with bargaining units prior to implementation. First, they contended that there was no specific date by which they were obligated to be in compliance with the Court's September 27 order. In the absence of such a date, they asserted they would have to bargain prior to implementation. Second, they suggested that COVID-19 may not currently constitute an emergency permitting implementation prior to bargaining.
- 11. Defendants asserted one additional reason for delaying implementation at the October 18 conference: they needed more time to have their anticipated motion for a stay decided prior to beginning implementation. Asked about the timing of filing that motion, Defendants declined to say any more than that it may be filed this week.
- 12. At the conclusion of the October 18 conference, at the urging of Receiver's counsel, it was agreed that a conference including labor relations staff would be necessary to determine whether agreement on a timeframe for implementation was possible. Receiver's counsel requested to meet that afternoon and confirmed that both Receiver's counsel and Migdalia Siaca, Deputy Director, Labor Relations, CCHCS, were prepared to

attend a conference that afternoon. Receiver's counsel also asked whether Defendants could confirm a time during the conference when CDCR labor relations staff would be available to meet. Defendants said that they would have to follow up with a time. Counsel for the Receiver asked that the meeting occur as soon as possible, on the afternoon of October 18, or the morning of October 19. At 6:08 pm, Mr. McClain wrote to offer a meeting at 3:00 pm the following day, October 19. Receiver's counsel accepted that meeting. This correspondence is also included in Exhibit D.

13. Counsel for the Receiver and Defendants, as well as CDCR and CCHCS labor relations staff met and conferred again on October 19, 2021 at 3:00 pm. At the meet and confer, Defendants asserted definitively that, absent a court order or emergency, they believed that notice and an opportunity to bargain over impacts would be required prior to implementation. Defendants said that they could begin implementation immediately if the Court ordered compliance by a particular date. When pressed for their position as to whether implementation could begin immediately under the emergency exception in the Dills Act, Defendants stated that they have not yet reached a decision whether they would be willing to invoke the Dills Act emergency exception to proceed with implementation prior to bargaining.

# JOINT IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR MANDATORY VACCINATION

# CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (CDCR) AND REHABILITATION AND CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL HEALTH CARE SERVICES (CCHCS)

The following joint implementation plan is submitted in order to comply with the *Order Re: Mandatory Vaccinations* issued on September 27, 2021 by the Honorable Jon S. Tigar, District Judge for the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, in the *Plata vs. Newsom* class action lawsuit. (ECF No. 3684.)<sup>1</sup>

# **APPLICATION OF ORDER RE: MANDATORY VACCINATION**

- 1. Mandatory vaccination shall apply to the following individuals identified as workers:
  - All CDCR/CCHCS and CALPIA employees, retired annuitants, health care registry workers, and contract workers (who work directly with incarcerated persons) who enter CDCR institution grounds for the performance of job duties, including Headquarters and Regional staff who may enter CDCR institution grounds for any purpose including the performance of job duties.
  - All CDCR/CCHCS peace officers, including retired annuitants, who may need to perform work at an institution, regardless of work location.
  - All volunteers who enter CDCR institution grounds to provide services or programming.

Mandatory vaccination shall apply to the following incarcerated persons identified as workers:

- All Inmate/Ward Labor Program casual tradespersons, who may work outside their institution.
- All incarcerated persons who perform job duties outside of a CDCR institution.
- 2. Mandatory vaccination shall apply to all incarcerated persons who have in-person visitation.
- 3. Mandatory vaccination does not apply to individuals who may enter CDCR institution grounds for official business and are not CDCR/ CCHCS or CalPIA employees. However, these individuals shall comply with all applicable California Department of Public Health (CDPH) mandates and guidelines that govern high-risk settings, congregate facilities, or correctional facilities and that are in effect at the time of entry into the institution.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> This submission is made by CDCR in a good faith effort to comply with the Court's Order (ECF No. 3684). Nothing set forth herein is intended to act as or to indicate forfeiture or voluntary relinquishment by CDCR of any and all issues cognizable in any appeal of the Order. Indeed, CDCR continues to have serious reservations about the impact of implementing this plan on staffing and operations statewide.

# TIMEFRAME AND VERIFICATION PROCESS TO COMPLY WITH JOINT IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR MANDATORY VACCINATION

All individuals and incarcerated persons identified above (refer to 1 and 2) shall be fully vaccinated<sup>2</sup> before November 29, 2021.<sup>3</sup> Vaccinations are provided at no cost to CDCR/CCHCS workers and incarcerated persons and may be obtained onsite from scheduled vaccination clinics. Alternatively, CDCR/CCHCS workers opting to obtain vaccination outside CDCR/CCHCS may select another clinic listed on the website <u>myturn.ca.gov</u> or their personal health care provider and shall follow the established process for submitting proof of vaccination to CDCR/CCHCS.

### TIMEFRAME FOR NEW EMPLOYEES

Newly-hired CDCR/CCHCS and CALPIA civil service employees, retired annuitants, health care registry providers, contract workers (who work directly with the incarcerated population), and peace officers shall obtain their first dose of a two-dose vaccine, or single dose of a one-dose vaccine, or submit a request for religious or reasonable accommodation, within 10 business days of their start date. New and current advertisements for civil service jobs and registry/contract assignments will be updated to reflect the mandatory vaccination requirement.

### **REQUESTS FOR ACCOMMODATIONS FROM MANDATORY VACCINATION**

All individuals and incarcerated persons identified as workers (refer to 1 and 2, above) may submit an accommodation request to be exempted from mandatory vaccination based on a sincerely-held religious belief.

With the exception of health care registry and contract workers, individuals and incarcerated persons identified as workers (refer to 1 and 2, above) may submit an accommodation request to be exempted from mandatory vaccines due to a qualifying medical reason(s). Health care registry and contract workers shall direct requests for medical accommodations to their respective contractor/employer.

Requests for religious or reasonable medical accommodation should be submitted on or before October 29, 2021 for timely processing. If the accommodation is denied, the worker has 10 days to initiate a vaccination.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup>Fully vaccinated is two weeks after the second of two Moderna or Pfizer vaccines, or two weeks after the single Johnson and Johnson vaccine.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> In order to meet this deadline, November 14, 2021 is the latest date that the second of the two-dose Moderna or Pfizer vaccines, or the single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine can be received.

# CONSEQUENCES OF NON-COMPLIANCE

Employees identified as workers (refer to 1, above) shall be subject to progressive discipline if they do not comply with the vaccination requirement and timeframe for compliance and do not have a request for accommodation for religious or medical reason(s) in process or approved. Progressive discipline shall commence on November 15, 2021.

<u>Effective November 29, 2021</u>, incarcerated persons identified in 1 and 2 shall receive vaccine counseling and, if out-of-compliance after [time period], to reduce the risk of introduction of COVID-19 into CDCR institutions, shall lose eligibility to hold jobs outside of institutions or conduct in-person visitation, until such time as they are in compliance.

All health care registry, contract, or volunteer workers who do not comply with the vaccination requirement and timeframe for compliance and do not have a request for accommodation for religious or medical reason(s) in process or approved may have their assignments ended on or after November 15, 2021.
