20 members.

21 3. Communications with counsel and visitors. Status of tablets? Cleaning  
22 procedures for tablets. Phones? Video? Discuss plaintiffs' request for free access while on  
23 lockdown.

24 4. SRJ staff and supplies. Sufficient resources? PPE for all? Ventilators?

25 5. N.D. Cal. Santa Rita Task Force. Update from the Court.

26 6. Document discovery requested by Plaintiffs from Wellpath/County.

27 7. Is a further reduction in the SRJ Class Member population necessitated by the  
28 COVID-19 pandemic? Explain impact on public health and safety.
