

 32 prisoners, and female prisoners.

1 It Is Further Ordered that the members of the class

4 to this order. Every person confined in the Yuba County Jail for
5 more than 48 hours shall be given a copy of the notice by an
6 officer of the Jail for his or her personal use and Jail person-
7 nel shall note in the appropriate Jail log that such notice has
8 been given to the particular individual. It shall be the respon-
9 sibility of California Rural Legal Assistance, the attorneys
10 representing the class herein, to provide the Yuba County Jail
11 with a sufficient number of copies of said notice so that the
12 defendants herein will be able to comply with this order. ✓
