AND REHABILITATION (as of February 24, 2021)**

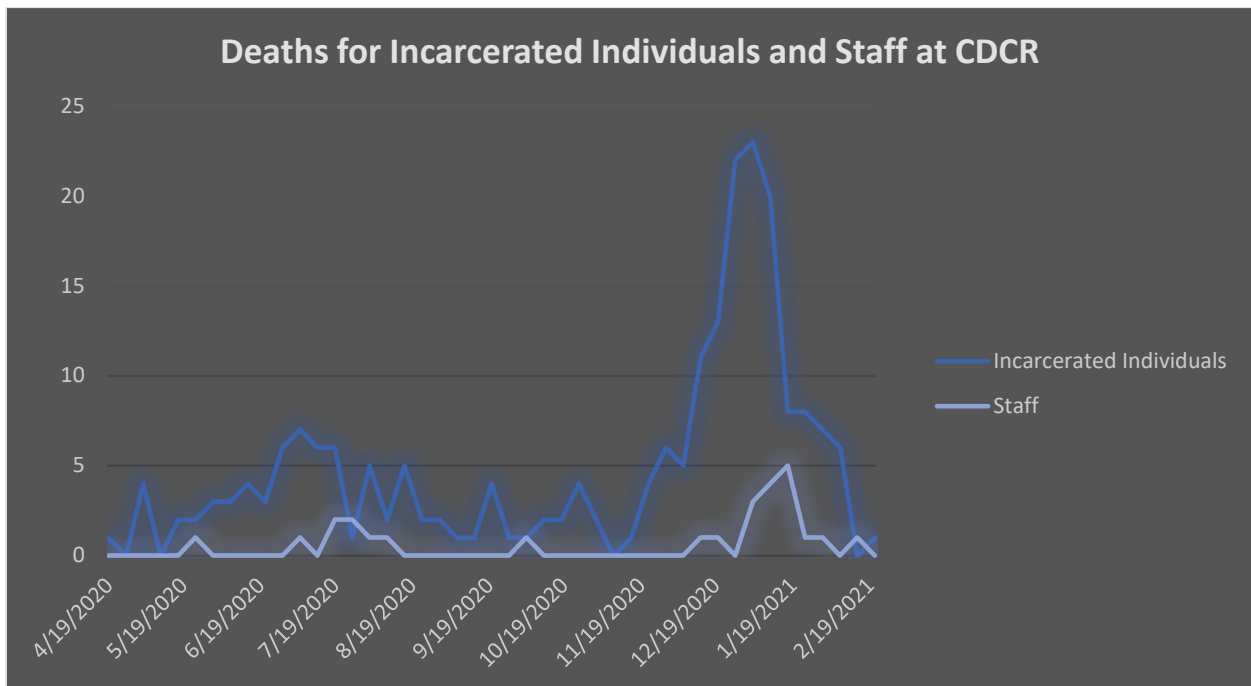
